

**Ashmolean Museum Picture Library Policy Statement regarding images from:
Helen Clifford, *A Treasured Inheritance: 600 Years of Oxford College Silver* (2004)**

Following the publication of *A Treasured Inheritance: 600 Years of Oxford College Silver* to coincide with an exhibition held at the Ashmolean Museum in 2004, the Picture Library receives a number of queries regarding images from the Oxford college silver collections.

Owing to an agreement entered into at the time of the exhibition, the Ashmolean did not retain images of all the works featured in the catalogue or the exhibition. The majority of images were returned to the colleges in question while the Ashmolean kept some duplicate images on file. Subsequent to the exhibition, objects from the Founders Plate of Corpus Christi College were deposited with the Ashmolean on long-term loan. A number of objects from All Souls College are also on long-term loan to the museum (see below) as well as the Communion Plate of the University Church of St Mary the Virgin.

All other objects returned to their relevant colleges at the conclusion of the exhibition and do not form part of the Ashmolean's collection. As a consequence the Ashmolean can only provide the following images of college silver (numbers in parentheses refer to catalogue numbers from *A Treasured Inheritance*, while 'L' numbers indicate Ashmolean Loan):
